## RESIDENTIAL AFTER-CARE INSTRUCTIONS

HERE ARE SOME RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF YOUR NEWLY RESTORED NATURAL STONE AREAS:

## DO's

- Do use P24 Stone Soap neutral cleaner or dilute Ivory or Lux dishwashing liquid. Always rinse well, squeegee dry, and/or buff dry.
- Do clean natural stone with unbleached cotton cloths, a clean oil-free mop, or a clean white buffing pad.
- Do sweep frequently to keep all residue off of stone surfaces. This prevents unnecessary scratches and etches. Use a soft oil-free dust mop.
- Do read the labels on your household cleaners. Don't use any cleaners that contain acids, ammonia, vinegar, lemon or citrus acids, bleach, oils, or heavy alkalines.
- Do seal your floor or other natural stone surfaces periodically with a penetrating seal for natural stone. Sealants are not complete protections; immediately blot up spills, and keep acids and heavy alkaline off of stone surfaces.
- Do allow 72 hours for stone seals to fully cure in food preparation areas. Food may be safely placed directly on the stone surface after full cure time.
- Do protect your floor surfaces with non-slip mats and countertops with trivets, coasters, and placemats.

## DON'TS

- Don't use waxes or topcoat sealants.
- Don't use flax soap or oil soap; these cleaners can create a film which is very difficult to remove.
- Don't use abrasive cleaners and don't scrub hard.
